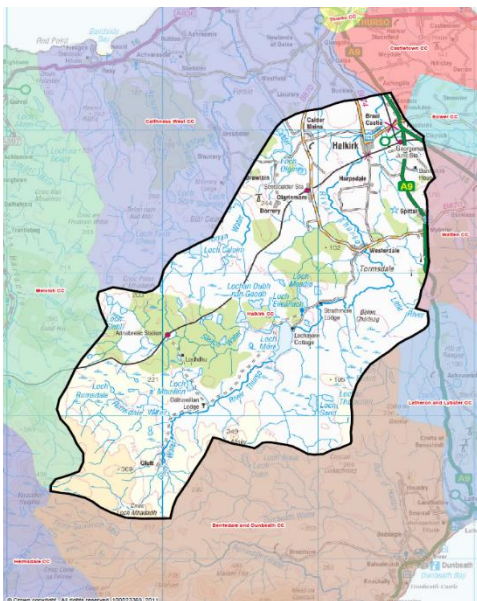
Welcome to the Halkirk District Benefit Fund Newsletter 2019.
