MINUTES OF MEMBERS MEETING HELD IN THE ROSS INSTITUTE, HALKIRK, CAITHNESS ON 18 JUNE 2009 AT 7.10

1. Most Recent Grant Aid Awards:

Mrs Cartwright detailed the most recent grant awards that were listed in the Grant Aid Awards table.

2. Criteria for Awarding Grant Aid to Individuals:

Mrs Cartwright informed the meeting that individuals may apply to HDBF for grants as long as they are members or members applying for a minor or a vulnerable adult. If any member is reaching exceptional standards in sports, music, the arts or education, grant aid can be applied for. It was considered better for a letter to be sent detailing the reason for the request rather than a grant aid form.

3. HDBF Website update:

It was hoped that the website would be up and running by 1st September 2009. It would then be more cost-effective for information to be sent to members electronically rather than by post.

4. Clarification of Voting by Representatives of Clubs:

To ensure that voting is correct when there are proxy forms and people have an individual and a group vote we need to ensure that both votes are included and this means showing two hands not one to ensure that the proxy form has been ratified.

5. Current Number of Members, Groups and Organisations:

Membership has been creeping up for individuals but groups and organisations make up only 15-20, potentially probably only about half of the groups in the area. Grant aid forms will be available at Halkirk and Westerdale Post Offices shortly.

6. Questions from the floor:

- **Q:** Is there a time limit on money allocated?
- A: Yes. This had recently been a subject of consideration and in future there will be a time limit on large amounts. This will avoid large amounts of money being tied up for a long time when it could be better invested.
- Q: How much does it cost to send the children to Fairburn?

 Mrs Cartwright was unaware of the exact amount and suggested the member ask the school.
